



Week 12 Questions and Answers

In keeping with what Lillian covered at the beginning of the Week 11 session, we asked Dr. Day to only address questions that are directly related to the material covered. Here are those questions raised but not answered during the live session.

Questions are in **BOLD**. Dr. Day's answers follow each question. Names are removed to protect privacy.

Q – How long will the videos and notes be available on the site, after the class?
[From Lillian] The videos will be up as long as we have internet, or as long as they are allowed on the server.

Q – Do you think if one spouse gets the vaccine and the other does not, can you be contaminated through sex?

I don't know the answer to that question. But what I do know, is that the consequences of the "vaccine" will be so devastating, that the question you just asked will be the LEAST of you and your spouse's concerns.

Q – I understand chemo patients cannot have sex with their partners because they can contaminate their partner?

That prohibition is only for 48–72 hours after the chemo treatment.

Q – Romans 8:14 KJV "For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God." So, does this happen in the next Eon for most of the world?

The next Eon will be the millennial eon when no human beings will be alive on earth. If one is not saved at the Second Coming of Christ, their “reaping” will occur in the LAST eon, after the Judgment.

Q – How many free lessons and courses are available where we can access you even in your children’s classes.

I don’t give any classes on a regular basis. I write books and people can read them if they wish.

Q – Dr. Day, if we need good gut bacteria, would sauerkraut (cabbage and juice) be not a good choice, even if we are on a good vegan lifestyle?

If you are living, thinking, acting, eating, and handling stress God’s way, you don’t have to do anything special to have good gut bacteria.

Q – A wonderful Christian, Dana Ashlie, did an interview with a man working with the guy who created the first HAARP. He said that the people involved in the operations all were taking a pinch of borax (3xday) to INACTIVATE the nanotech in the body. Do you have any position on this, Dr day?

I have not investigated the use of – or safety of – ingesting borax, a household cleaning product, as an inactivator of nanotech in the body. It would not be something I would do.

Q – Dear Dr Day, I have a question: What happened to the Ark of the Covenant and the 10 commandments written on stone? I always wondered where did they end up? Who took them? I don’t seem to find what happened to them. Maybe I haven’t read my Bible carefully and missed it?

The Bible doesn’t say anything about where they are, physically. And archeologists do not know.

Q – Or maybe God took them because they are so important and precious? In the Book of Revelation, they appear again?

They “appear” in Revelation to show us that they are the character of God, they are permanent, and we are to follow them implicitly. And the only way we can do that is if God has put His character and disposition into our heart and mind.

Q – Dr Day: One of your books says There are consequences for sin, just punishment.

My books say there is no “punishment” FOR sin – just consequences OF sin. In other words, God doesn’t “punish” us for sinning. We just reap what we have sown.

Q – Dr Day: If there haven't been any of God's prophets since Jesus, then what about EGW. Was she of Satan? Were her dreams and visions from Satan? (Ellen G. White)

Q – Dr Day in the Book of Hosea 6: 2–3 – “After two days will he revive us: in the third day he will raise us up, and we shall live in his sight. Then shall we know, if we follow on to know the Lord: his going forth is prepared as the morning; and he shall come unto us as the rain, as the latter and former rain unto the earth.” My question is about the two days and the third day: in this context, could those days represent a thousand year each or could it have another symbolic time/duration meaning? Thank you so much. I learned so much I would have never learned that much on my own!

It's impossible to take one short passage from the Bible and interpret it separately from a study of that particular issue in the entire Bible. And studying that issue from the entire Bible would take too long for a Question-and-Answer forum such as this. But I do discuss the early rain and the latter rain in my book, ‘Getting Started on Getting Well.’

Q – How can I reconcile the verse 1John 9.10 that says "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us for our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness". Will we have to reap consequences then?

Reaping the consequences of what we have sown IS the WAY God “cleanses us from all unrighteousness” because that is the way we learn NOT to do it again!

Q – Those believers who will be lifted up at the 2nd coming means that they have been perfected in this life and will not have any more consequences in this life?

The ones who are taken to heaven at the Second Coming of Christ will already have reaped – in this life – what they have sown. The rest will “reap what they have sown” after the Judgment. No one escapes “reaping what they have sown.”

Q – You have been saying so much about Acts 2 but I wonder since you honor the entire scriptures, why you didn't comment on Acts 10:44–46 Peter at Cornelius's house and Acts 19:6 Paul at Ephesus and Pauls teaching and instruction in I Cor. 14.... where he ends the chapter by saying he doesn't forbid to speak in tongues.

The word, again, is “languages” – referring to KNOWN languages of the time, not unintelligible gibberish. The episode at Cornelius’ home was to specifically show the Israelites that God loved the non-Israelites just as much. And when they (the non-Israelites) followed God, He bestowed on them the same abilities.

Q – Off topic, but my foot had a large computer dropped on it and it’s been a year or two and it still hurts. The doctor said no bones are broken now that it’s been a year, and I finally went to the doctor. Should I let it heal naturally with time? Since the doctor doesn’t know why my foot still hurts? If it’s the ligaments split, do you believe it will heal with time? And I should just move on with my life and ignore the slight pain from it?

I wouldn’t be able to comment without examining your foot and seeing your x-rays.

Q – Not a pleasant death for all the vaccine takers but what about for the ones who resist?

I’m sorry, I don’t understand your question.

Q – If I were to give one book as a gift you wrote Dr. Day, which book would it be?

If you want to give a book about health, I would suggest, “I Will Give You Back Your Health Again.” If you want to give a book about the study of the Bible – if the person enjoys reading, give “Who Rewrote the Bible?” If the person is not a big reader, give “If Jesus Died for All, Why Can’t He Save All?” (because it is a much smaller book).

Q – What is the reason for the Zombie Preparedness? Is it because the Vax will cause Prion Disease or CJD/Mad Cow disease and people will go crazy mad?

Yes, this is correct.

Q – Or is it because the 5G once connected to the nanotechnology in the Vax will cause madness and people behaving zombie-like?

This might also be a problem, but I don’t have the documentation for this at present. However, we certainly do know that 5G is harmful to the body, and we also know that they want to implant everyone with nanotechnology.

Q – My mom and I learned about Ron Wyatt, an amazing and humble man of God. He says he found the ark of the covenant, Mt. Sinai, and Noah’s ark. I would recommend going to ronwyatt.com

Ron Wyatt has been saying for many years that he has found Noah’s ark, but it has never been excavated, so it can’t be documented.

Q – Dr. Day, what is the best way to determine who to tithe to, to help give them a " leg up?"

Do your own investigation, then pray about it, letting God lead you.

Q – And do we base our 10% tithe according to our yearly income?

It’s a good idea to pay one’s tithe each pay period, so it doesn’t get forgotten. If you want to save up through a couple of pay periods to send – or give – a larger amount, that is fine. But to let it go for a year may cause it to be forgotten.
